Why Šiauliai?

Šiauliai is the fastest-growing city in Lithuania for two consecutive years. It also boasts the lowest unemployment rate, with a rapidly increasing number of students and low labor cost, with an average wage of 1917 euros.

Šiauliai is the dominant economic center in northern Lithuania, with a highly accessible airport and a robust railway system. The Šiauliai area, located near the busy port cities of Klaipeda and Riga, provides a highly advantageous setting for logistics.

The city municipality is committed to ensuring and continually enhancing conditions for potential investors and established enterprises.

The economic prosperity of Siauliai derives from its highly proficient labor force, specializing in electronics manufacturing, metal processing, furniture production, and logistics.



Investment oasis: Šiauliai emerges as a prime destination for foreign capital.

The foreign direct investment within the municipal boundaries of Šiauliai has witnessed a growth exceeding fourfold during the period spanning from 2015 to 2022, demonstrating a sustained upward trajectory that persists to the present day.

ŠIAULIAI INDUSTRIAL PARK

The Šiauliai Industrial Park occupies almost 60 hectares of territory. Since establishing the Šiauliai Industrial Park, companies have invested more than 71.2 million euros here. Fourteen companies are currently operating in the park, with a workforce of about 6,400 employees.

The Šiauliai City Municipality Administration guarantees assistance and intermediation in obtaining building permits and communication with other institutions.

Companies that invest at least 600,000 euros per hectare and create at least five new jobs over ten years are exempt from real estate and land lease taxes.

Currently, there are three available plots in the Siauliai Industrial Park.

FEZ is a designated 132-hectare area subdivided into plots of different sizes, ranging from 1 to 25 hectares. These plots can be further merged or adjusted

The FEZ is strategically situated near the country's primary transportation routes and Šiauliai International Airport.

Enterprises operating inside the Šiauliai Free Economic Zone benefit from tax advantages on profits as well as on the exemption from property tax, and, under specific circumstances outlined by the profit tax legislation of the Republic of Lithuania, dividends are not liable to taxes.

The Free Economic Zone accommodates six enterprises with a cumulative investment of 25 million euros, creating around 300 fresh employment prospects.

Railway infrastructure sides both the Industrial Park and the Free Economic Zone.

The city of Šiauliai has a well-established and comprehensive public infrastructure that encompasses railway, land, and air transportation, ensuring efficient logistics for existing and future businesses.

The only airport in the Eastern part of the European Union to apply no restrictions on noise in the daytime and at night is also located in the city of Šiauliai. The largest in the Baltic's runway along with the state-of-the-art equipment allows servicing even the heaviest aircraft 24 hours a day year-round under the most challenging meteorological conditions.

Šiauliai International Airport offers:

- Operation hours 24/7.
- No noise restrictions.

CENTER FOR STUDY IN NORTH LITHUANIA


Pursuing academic education, gaining practical experience, and finding a job quickly improve future-oriented planning and lay the framework for a successful career.

Šiauliai hosts several notable academic institutions, including the Šiauliai Academy of Vilnius University, the Šiauliai State Higher Education Institution, and the Šiauliai Technology Training Center. A growing number of students opt to enroll in Šiauliai annually. In 2023, there was a 40% increase in the number of first-year students in the Academy while the State Higher Education Institution and the Technology Training Center reached full occupancy with the number of students increasing by 25% for the second consecutive year.

Academic institutions and businesses work closely together employing students upon completion of their studies, resulting in the city of Siauliai having the lowest youth unemployment rates in the country.
